DRIPPY PUMPKIN BOX



MATERIALS

- CCX3109 Pumpkin Box
 - ¾ Flat Brush
 - 8 Shader Brush
 - 6 Round Brush
 - 2 Round Brush
 - Sponge

CMM Color:

- 92 Ghostly Grape
- 104 Orange Juice
 - 55 Sea Mist
 - 17 Margarita
 - 31 Licorice

TIPS

 When watering the glaze to a milky consistency, use an appropriate ratio of one part glaze to one part water.
 If you add too much glaze, the color will not move enough for a dripping effect.
 If you add too much water, the color will be very light.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire piece to remove dust and contaminants.
- 2. Line up the lid to the bottom of the box and keep them together for Steps 3 and 4.
- 3. Starting with a watery brush, mix up the water with the glaze. Load up the brush, then starting at the bottom of where you want the stripe to be, pull your brush up towards the top of the pumpkin.
- 4. Alternate the different sizes of brushes and colors to create stripes on all sides of the pumpkin.
- 5. Paint clusters of short strokes, with each cluster painted in a different direction, with Licorice. See photo for reference.
- 6. Paint 2-3 coats of Licorice on the stem, letting each coat dry completely.
- 7. Clear glaze then stilt and fire to cone 06.
