

TECHNIQUE: WATERCOLOR

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB37473 Honeycomb Salad
Plate
Round Brushes
Liner Brush
Clean Water
Water Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 46 - Sunnyside Up CMM 57 - Squash Blossom CMM 55 - Sea Mist CMM 5 - Coral Reef CMM 45 - Indigo



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. For the best results we are starting with unpainted pottery.
- 2. Add water to each of the colors by adding equal parts paint and water.
- 3. Use your water based marker to sketch out your design. This marker will start to bleed when you paint over it. This will disappear in the firing.
- 4. Load up your brush with color and paint in your design using just one coat. To get the look of water color we don't need 3 layers of paint as we are not going for deep solid color.
- 5. Repeat until your design is complete.
- 6. This technique can also be used for filling in designs made with stamps or silkscreens.

TIPS

- When you mix up your paint, add 50% water to 50% paint.
- Only one coat of paint is needed for this technique.
