## TECHNIQUE: WATERCOLOR



## MATERIALS

DB37473 Honeycomb Salad
Plate
Round Brushes
Liner Brush
Clean Water
Water Based Marker

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. For the best results we are starting with unpainted pottery.
2. Add water to each of the colors by adding equal parts paint and water.
3. Use your water based marker to sketch out your design. This marker will start to bleed when you paint over it. This will disappear in the firing.
4. Load up your brush with color and paint in your design using just one coat. To get the look of water color we don't need 3 layers of paint as we are not going for deep solid color.
5. Repeat until your design is complete.
6. This technique can also be used for filling in designs made with stamps or silkscreens.

## TIPS

- When you mix up your paint, add $50 \%$ water to $50 \%$ paint.
- Only one coat of paint is needed for this technique.
